What is Honor Flight?

The Honor Flight Network is a national network of independent Hubs working together to honor our nation's veterans and with an all-expenses paid trip to the memorials in Washington D.C., a trip many of our veterans may not otherwise be able to take. Participation in an Honor Flight trip gives veterans the chance to share this momentous trip with other veterans, to remember friends and comrades lost and share their stories and experiences with each other.

Our Mission

The mission of Honor Flight is to celebrate America's veterans by inviting them to share in a day of honor at our nation's memorials.

Our Vision

A nation where all of America's veterans experience the honor, gratitude, and community of support they deserve.

Honor Flight Network is offering our Adopt-an-Honor Flight Day as an engaging way for your employees or members to give back via a community service opportunity in DC. A business/organization that chooses to Adopt-An-Honor-Flight-Day (at no cost to you) will supply employees / members to welcome veterans, guardians, and hub personnel as they arrive and/or departure at one of the three area airports decided by you (BWI, DCA or IAD). There are also opportunities to "adopt" multiple Honor Flight hubs as they arrive at the WWII Memorial on a given day. Some Saturdays are known as "Super-Saturdays" where up to 10 hubs may pass through the WWII Memorial.

Businesses/Organizations could choose to have their greeting team wear their own current branded gear or, with enough notice, work with the Honor Flight team to create a co-branded Ambassador shirt for employees to wear throughout their service day.

Depending on your availability and timeframe, some Honor Flight days will need volunteers for a few hours in the morning, and/or a few hours in the evening as the hubs are arriving/departing from the airport. On Super Saturdays, employees / members can stay for the entire day, or as possible.
